Admissions Criteria

Student must have the following to be considered for admission as an exchange student:

- o 'B' average
- o 610 (253 computer and 102 iBT based) TOEFL or 6.5 IELTS
- o At least one year in residence at home university

Note: TOEFL or IELTS and GRE test scores must be sent directly from Testing Services Office to the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (Institution Code: 1836, Department Code: 00). Students whose TOEFL is less than the 610 (253 computer and 102 iBT based) or IELTS is less than 7 will be required to take the English Placement Test upon arrival. Students may be required to enroll in certain English courses based on outcome of the test. (Intensive English Institute information at <http://www.iei.uiuc.edu/>) Proposed program may have additional admission criteria.

Application Deadline (Note: Application deadlines are firm--no late applications will be considered.)

Fall/AY Undergraduate Exchange Application Deadline: April 1

Spring Undergraduate Exchange Application Deadline: September 15

We encourage all students to apply early due to increased difficulties in obtaining visas to enter the U.S. Applications and test scores must be received by deadlines indicated. Access to University Housing could be affected by late applications.

The following documents have changed for 2010-2011, and we will not accept earlier versions:

- International Non-Degree Exchange Application (Must be signed by student and coordinator.)
- Declaration and Certification of Finances Statement (Students must verify \$7,700 USD/semester; \$15,400 USD/academic year.)
- Verification of Finance Letter (Remember that the Verification must be in English, and the name on the Verification must be an exact match to the name listed as the guarantor on the Declaration and Certification of Finances Statement. If the Verification is not in English and/or the names don't match exactly, this will result in a delay in the processing of the application.)

Please note, as outlined on the Projected Course and Projected Housing forms, this does not guarantee placement into specific courses or guarantee a specific housing type, it only provides us the information needed to place students in the proper department and get an idea of where they will be located for housing.
